Mass Feastdays for the week of September 29th
Mon., St. Jerome, priest, doctor of the Church: Jerome, died 420 at Bethlehem; from Dalmatia; devoted monk & ascetic; wrote numerous commentaries on & authored Latin ("Vulgate") translation of the Bible; one of the 4 great doctors of the Latin Church; patron of scripture scholars.

Tues., St. Therese of the Child Jesus, virgin, doctor of the Church: Therese Martin, the "Little Flower," died 1897 of tuberculosis in the Carmel of Lisieux at age 24; contemplative who, in her autobiography, *The Story of a Soul*, urged all to follow "the little way"; proclaimed a doctor of the Church by Pope John Paul II; patroness of the missions, florists & France.

Wed., the Holy Guardian Angels **Thur., Weekday** **Fri., St. Francis of Assisi:** Francis, died 1226; noted for his charismatic personality, deep compassion for all, & love for God's creation; renounced wealth to follow "Lady Poverty"; founded the Franciscan Family; wrote *Cantic of the Sun*; received the stigmata; canonized 2 years after his death; patron of ecologists & Italy.

Sat., Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos, Priest: Born in Germany in 1819, Francis Xavier Seelos entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer and was sent to North America. Served as an assistant pastor under St. John Neumann, later became a full-time itinerant missionary, preaching in both English and German in a number of different states. Declared "Blessed" in 2000.

A horrific decision was handed down earlier this year which allows live dismemberment abortion to continue in Kansas and opens the door for the virtual elimination of ALL pro-life legislation in Kansas.
