Mass Feastdays for the week of October 13th: Mon., St. Callistus I, pope, martyr: Callistus I, died 222; incurred ire of Tertullian & Hippolytus over lapsi controversy; organized the 1st official Christian cemetery in Rome & instituted Ember Day fasts. Tues., St. Teresa of Jesus, virgin, doctor of the Church: Teresa of Avila, died 1582 at Alba; Spanish mystic who, with St. John of the Cross, founded the reformed (Discalced) Carmelite friars & nuns, for which she had to endure great trials; authored *Way of Perfection*, *Interior Castle*, & an autobiography; 1st woman declared "Doctor of the Church" (1970); patroness of Spain. Wed., St. Hedwig, religious; St. Margaret Mary Alacque, virgin: Hedwig, died 1243; born in Bavaria; duchess of Silesia & mother of 7; peacemaker dedicated to the poor & prisoners; as a widow, retired to a Cistercian convent. Margaret Mary, died 1690 at age 43; French Visitandine mystic who promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a feast which helped free the Church from the spirit of Jansenism; promoted 1st Friday devotion. Thur., St. Ignatius of Antioch, bishop, martyr: Ignatius, died c. 107 under Trajan in Rome's amphitheater; Apostolic Father known as the 2nd successor of St. Peter in Antioch; wrote 7 letters to local communities on church unity & structure, especially the monoespiscopacy; first to use the term "Catholic Church" as a collective designation for Christians; mentioned in the Roman Canon. Fri., St. Luke, evangelist: Luke, died 1st c.; Syrian physician from Antioch & companion of St. Paul; authored (c. 70-85) Acts of the Apostles & a Gospel for gentle Christians; it speaks of God's mercy, universal salvation, love of the poor & the marginalized, absolute renunciation, prayer, & the Holy Spirit; represented by a winged ox; patron of the medical profession, painters, artists, sculptors, & butchers. Sat., Sts. John de Brebeuf & Isaac Jogues, priests, & companions, martyrs: French Jesuit & oblate missionaries to the Hurons & Iroquois of North America, died 1642-1649; Isaac was tomahawked to death by Iroquois in 1646 near Albany; John was savagely mutilated & slain in 1649 near Georgian Bay; secondary patrons of Canada. 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Ex 17:8-13 2 Tm 3:14–4:2 Lk 18:1-8

REVERSE THE RULING POSTCARD PETITION: The Kansas Supreme Court recently created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion in Kansas, effectively rolling back decades of enacted life-saving limits on abortion. 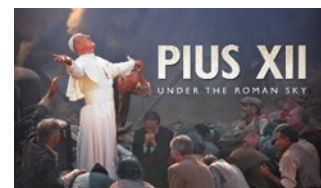

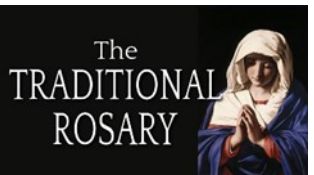
