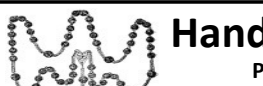

Mon., Sts. Simon & Jude, apostles: Simon, died 1st century;
called "the Canaanite" & also "the Zealot," an anti-Roman party;
possibly preached in Egypt & Persia; mentioned in the Roman
Canon. Jude, or Thaddeus ("Courageous"), died 1st century; may have preached in
Palestine & Persia; mentioned in the Roman Canon; patron of those in despair, or in
hopeless situations (perhaps because of the similarity of his name with that of Judas
Iscaiot, who betrayed Jesus & despaired.)

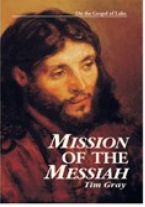


SOUP SUPPER & WHITE ELEPHANT BINGO: St. Mark's A.S. is hosting a soup supper
