Mon., St. Charles Borromeo, bishop: Charles Borromeo, died 1584 at age 46; cardinal & secretary of state at age 22 for his uncle, Pope Pius IV; implemented reforms of Trent in his diocese of Milan; founder of seminaries; considered a model pastor by many bishops, including St. Francis de Sales; held 5 provincial councils & 11 diocesan synods; patron of catechists & of catechumens.

ALL SOULS**

The month of November begins with the Feast of All Saints; the following day we commemorate the Faithful Departed on All Souls Day.

Rarely is a whole month devoted to a single theme such as we are now observing; still more rarely does the theme harmonize so perfectly with the world of nature about us - everything we experience aids us to be mindful of the end, of death:

- Frosts have killed off plant life;
- The trees stand naked and barren of leaves;
- Darkness is steadily encroaching upon light as the days grow shorter and nights longer;
- Cold, ice, snow all help to accent the end of things.

Never is there such concerted effort from all sides to bring home the reality of death, and to make us think of that which follows thereafter: judgment, resurrection, heaven, or hell.
