Feast days for the week of November 17th

Mon., The Dedication of the Basilica of Sts. Peter & Paul, apostles; St. Rose Philippine Duchesne, virgin: Rose Philippine Duchesne, died 1852 at age 83 in Missouri; from Grenoble, France; founded the 1st American house of the Religious of the Sacred Heart; opened the 1st American free school west of the Mississippi; known for her courage & desire to serve Native Americans, esp. the Potawatomi who called her the "woman who prays always." Tues., Weekday Wed., Weekday
Thur., The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Fri., St. Cecilia, virgin, martyr: Cecilia, died 3rd century; honored in Rome since the 5th century; mentioned in the Roman Canon; patroness of sacred music because of the song of God in her heart.
Sat., St. Clement I, pope, martyr; St. Columban, abbot; Blessed Miguel Agustin Pro, priest, martyr: Clement I, died c. 100 under Trajan; 4th bishop of Rome; wrote famous epistle to the Corinthians; mentioned in the Roman Canon. Columban, died 615; Irish monk & missionary to France; wrote a strict monastic rule & Penitential; founded monasteries; exiled to Italy for denouncing court immorality & lax bishops; died at Bobbio. Miguel Pro, died Nov. 23, 1927 at age 36; from Guadalupe, Mexico; S.J. noted for his sympathetic nature & firm piety; during Mexican religious persecution, he was accused of plotting against the government & was executed while exclaiming, "Long live Christ the King!"

FROM A PARISHIONER

Dear Friends and Family,

I awoke this morning and I asked God, "What can I do to carry out Your will?" The answer came to me almost immediately. (I have been given the message many times since I regained consciousness in the hospital in 2018.)

Last year I died to this life, and was sent back, changed, and with a message. The message is that "our personal judgement day and time is not known to us. Therefore, be prepared." I certainly did not expect my life to change so abruptly in 2018. In my complacency I believed that I was 'good enough.' I see now that I was not 'good enough' and that I was a fool. We will be judged by the Word of God; not by what we think, or by societal norms. I was sent back to this life for the purpose of making known this message from God: "Prepare yourselves for your inevitable judgement."

Just suppose, you are suddenly scheduled to meet Jesus tomorrow at 2pm at a location of His choosing. Be serious, what would be your initial thoughts or actions?

1. Am I ready? (this is totally unexpected).
2. Cancel the appointment (but you can't).
3. Hide (but you can't).
4. You say to Jesus, "I have accepted you as my Lord and Savior." Jesus will ask you what works you have done to carry out God's will. Jesus may say He has not heard from you for a long time. You may say I was too busy with things in life. And Jesus may say, "I do not know you."
5. You say to Jesus, "Please give me more time, Jesus, and I will do better." God may say, "I gave you the Bible, I gave you My son Jesus who was crucified for your sins, and I gave you sacramental gifts. Yet, you choose to live in the world. Everything you see in the world is temporary. Everything that you can't see, and may have ignored, is eternal." Jesus may say, "I do not know you."
6. Hopefully you will hear God say, "Welcome, well done My good and faithful servant."

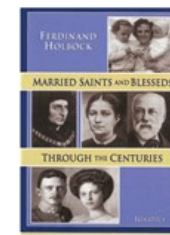

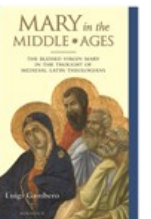
MEN'S CURSILLO GROUP will begin meeting after the 8am Friday Marion Mass. If there is no Mass, the group will not meet.
