Feast days for the week of Dec. 29th: Mon., Sixth Day within the Octave of the Nativity of the Lord Tues., St. Sylvester I, Pope: Sylvester, died 335; as bishop of Rome [314-335], organized public worship & dedicated the Lateran basilica; represented at the Council of Nicea which condemned Arianism; one of the 1st non-martyrs venerated as a saint.

Wed., Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God Thur., Sts. Basil the Great & Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops, Doctors of the Church: Basil, died Jan. 1, 379; hermit who became bishop of Caesarea in Cappadocia; noted for his learning; foe of Arianism; wrote a rule on monasticism; source of Eucharistic Prayer IV; along with Sts. Gregory Nazianzen, Athanasius, & John Chrysostom, considered one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church. Gregory Nazianzen, died Jan. 25, 389 or 390; Patriarch of Constantinople; noted for his knowledge of sacred Scripture; called *theologus* for his outstanding teaching abilities & eloquence. **Fri., The Most Holy Name of Jesus** Sat., St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Religious: Elizabeth Ann Bayley Seton, died 1821; raised Episcopalian; wife & mother of 5 children; foundress of the 1st congregation for women religious in USA, the Sisters of Charity, devoted primarily to the education of the poor & to teaching in parochial schools; 1st native-born citizen canonized. **Epiphany of the Lord:** Is 60:1-6 Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6 Mt 2:1-12

Thy hopes and plans, thy work or rest.

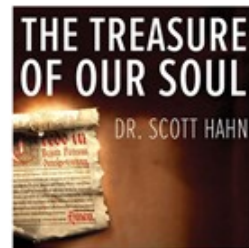
