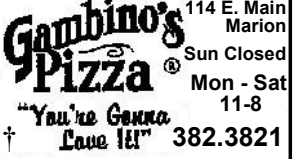

Feast days for the week of Jan. 19th: Mon., St. Fabian, pope, martyr; St. Sebastian, martyr: Fabian, died 250 under Decius; layman elected bishop of Rome in 236; an "incomparable man, the glory of whose death corresponded with the holiness of his life"; his body came to be transferred from the catacombs of Callistus to the basilica of St. Sebastian. Sebastian, died 288 at Rome under Diocletian; chief of the Praetorian cohort whose *acta* tells of his being pierced by arrows, later being clubbed to death; patron of archers, soldiers, & police associations. Tues., St. Agnes, virgin, martyr: Agnes, died beginning of 4th c. under Diocletian at the age of 12; patroness of Christian virtue confronted by political & social violence; represented with a martyr's palm & a lamb (her name in Latin is lamb); the wool from 2 lambs blessed today will be used to make the pallia which are presented by the pope to Metropolitans on June 29; name mentioned in the Roman Canon. Wed., Weekday Thur., St. Vincent, deacon, martyr; St. Marianne Cope, virgin: Vincent, died c. 304 in persecution of Diocletian at Valencia; patron of wine producers. Marianne Cope, died 1918; a religious of the Sisters of St. Francis of Syracuse, NY; known for her charitable works & virtuous deeds; for 35 years cared for the lepers on the island of Moloka'i; canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2012. Fri., St. Francis de Sales, bishop, doctor of the Church: Francis de Sales, died 1622; bishop of Geneva; sought to bring many back to the Church through his personal life & writings, especially his *Controversies* & several devout treatises, including his *Introduction to the Devout Life*; co-founder with St. Jane Frances de Chantal of the Visitation Order; patron of writers, journalists, & the deaf. 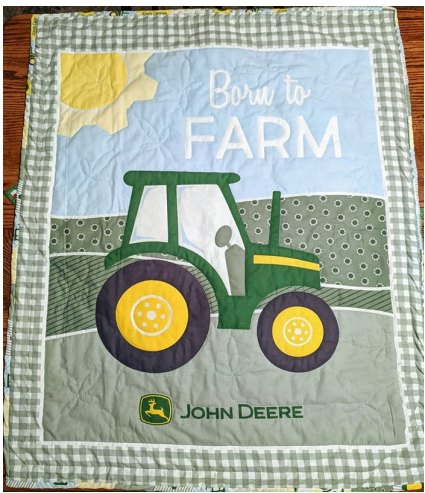
