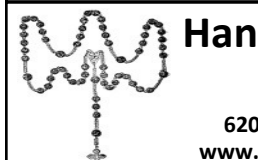
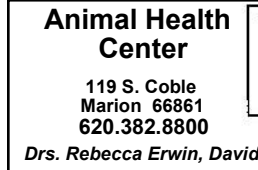

Feast days for the week of Jan. 26th

Mon., St. Angela Merici, virgin: Angela Merici, died 1540 at Brescia; orphaned at ten; foundress of the Ursulines, the first teaching Order especially for poor young girls; sought re-evangelization of families through the education of future wives & mothers.

Tues., St. Thomas Aquinas, priest, doctor of the Church: Thomas Aquinas, died 1274; O.P.; the "Angelic Doctor" who wrote the *Summa Theologiae* and authored *Adoro te devote*, *O salutaris*, *Tantum ergo*, and *Pange lingua*; patron of Catholic schools, colleges, & universities, of philosophers, theologians, & booksellers.

Fri., St. John Bosco, priest: John Bosco, died 1888 at Turin; founded the Salesians, today numbering around 15,270 members; dedicated to educating youth; with St. Mary Mazzarello, founded the Salesian Sisters; a pioneer in vocational training; first saint in history to submit to a press interview; 40,000 people filed past his body at his death; first canonized saint in whose honor a national holiday was declared in Italy; patron of editors; known as the "Apostle of Youth."

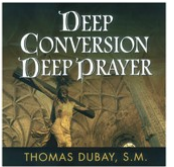
