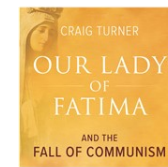

YAHOO GROUPS IS BACK! However, it is different than what it was in the past. The old Yahoo Groups did not allow anyone but the moderator to send out messages to the entire group, unless the message was approved by the moderator. The new Yahoo Groups allows anyone to send a message to the group. This is a nice feature, but can easily be abused, so for the Holy Family Parish Yahoo Group, which will be a private group, the "rule" will be that only the moderator can send out messages. To break this rule is to be removed from the group. The Yahoo Groups will only be used to send out bulletins, funeral notices, reminders, or cancellation of parish events, such as daily Mass or PSR. Please contact the church office with your email address if you would like to be part of the new Yahoo Group.

CONFIRMATION 6TH GRADE & UP will be in PL on Wed., Jan. 13, 2021. The Diocese has lowered the age for Confirmation to 6th grade, so 6th graders & older next school year can be confirmed. They must be registered in the parish, attend Mass on Sundays & Holy Days, attend regular PSR classes for their grade plus a few separate special Confirmation classes, and fulfill the Confirmation requirements. There will be a parents meeting in the spring to explain everything.
