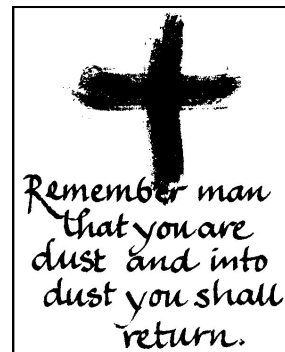

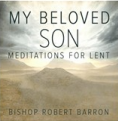
Church Regulations Regarding Fast and Abstinence
Abstinence from meat (beast or fowl) is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years & older on Ash Wednesday & on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits eating meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments, even though made from animal fat. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a fast day. Catholics who are 18 years old but not yet 59 years are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Also, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted.

YAHOO GROUPS IS BACK! However, it is different than what it was in the past. The old Yahoo Groups did not allow anyone but the moderator to send out messages to the entire group, unless the message was approved by the moderator. The new Yahoo Groups allows anyone to send a message to the group. This is a nice feature, but can easily be abused, so for the Holy Family Parish Yahoo Group, which will be a private group, the "rule" will be that only the moderator can send out messages. To break this rule is to be removed from the group. The Yahoo Groups will only be used to send out bulletins, funeral notices, reminders, or cancellation of parish events, such as daily Mass or PSR.
