But a dolphin in a tree would be a very grotesque affair, and there would be no wisdom of God to admire, in trout singing in the groves. But when the fish cuts the wave with agile fins, it is adapting wonderfully to its habitat. Its every bone is fitted for the circumstances in which it finds itself."

So God has matched our souls to our circumstances. We are not in our present situation by accident. Let us glorify Him **where we are!**

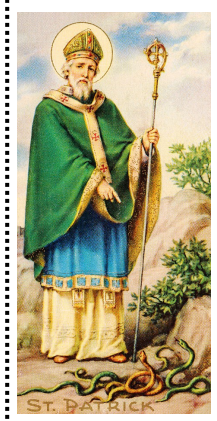
CONFIRMATION FOR 6TH GRADE & UP will be in PL on Wed., Jan. 13, 2021. The Diocese has lowered the age for Confirmation to 6th grade, so 6th graders & older next school year can be confirmed. They must be registered in the parish, attend Mass on Sundays & Holy Days, attend regular PSR classes for their grade plus a few separate special Confirmation classes, and fulfill the Confirmation requirements. A parents meeting will be held on Sun., April 26th, MAC at 7pm, to explain everything.

UPDATE ON FATHER KAPAUN'S CAUSE FOR CANONIZATION

From Father John Hotze, Episcopal Delegate
 During Bishop Kemme's recent Ad Limina visit to Rome, he visited the Congregation for Saints, who confirmed that Fr. Kapaun's Cause was on their calendar. On March 10, a panel of Cardinals and Archbishops from the Congregation for Saints will discuss and vote whether we have sufficiently proven that Fr. Kapaun lived a life of heroic virtue and sanctity. If the panel of Cardinals and Archbishops reach an affirmative decision, the Cardinal Prefect of the Congregation for Saints will present Fr. Kapaun's case to the Holy Father at a later date. The Holy Father will then decide whether Fr. Kapaun should be given the title of "Venerable." Please continue to pray for the advancement of Father Kapaun's Cause. Remember to keep the members of the Congregation for Saints in prayer as they make this decision on March 10. Also pray that we may continue to be patient as we await these decisions. It will still take some time for the decision to make its way to the Holy Father and then some time for Pope Francis to weigh the decision as to whether Fr. Kapaun is given the name Venerable. While granting Fr. Kapaun the title "Venerable" demonstrates the Church's belief in Fr. Kapaun's virtuous life, the Church still requires the additional proof of two miracles attributed to Fr. Kapaun's intercession, one for Beatification and another one that occurs after Beatification for Sainthood.
