Mon., Lenten Weekday
Tues., St. Patrick, bishop: Patrick, died 461 at Down; born about 389 of Romano-British origin, perhaps in Wales; founded metropolitan See of Armagh; authored *Confessio*, and the famous *Lorica* (Lat., "breastplate"), a work praising Christ; patron of Nigeria; apostle & patron of Ireland.
Wed., St. Cyril of Jerusalem, bishop, doctor of the Church: Cyril, died 386; great pastor & teacher; ordained bishop of Jerusalem in 348; authored 18 "Catecheses" & 5 "Mystagogical Catecheses" devoted to the liturgy & the sacraments; exiled 3 times by the Arians.
Thur., St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Honored on March 19 since end of 10th c.; declared Patron of Universal Church in 1870 by Pope Pius IX; patron of workers, carpenters & fathers; also of Austria, Belgium, Bohemia, Canada, Mexico, Peru & south Vietnam; mentioned in Eucharistic Prayers I-IV.

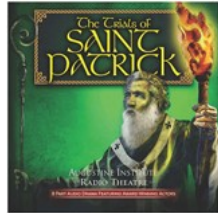

HUNGRY FOR CHRIST: A few years ago, Holy Family Parish formed a Fasting Group for encouragement & support. The goal of the group is to fast on Fridays throughout the year for the salvation of souls and any other intentions. **Here's how it works:** You will receive an email prior to the fast day. You choose the level at which you would like to participate. After the fast day, you will receive an email that will call for a self-determined "grade" on a scale of 0-10. This is purely voluntary, but it allows the facilitator to report an aggregate of our efforts. You should give yourself extra credit for attending Mass, a holy hour & other devotions. Add one credit for each item added to the fast. You should subtract from your score if you are lacking in charity, such as being cross with your family or others. For the calendar year 2019, fasting hours recorded were 16,767.4.
