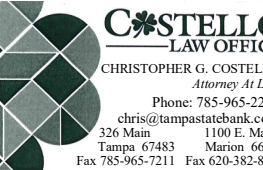

Feast days for the week of May 10th: Mon., Easter Weekday Tues., Sts. Nereus & Achilles, martyrs; St. Pancras, martyr: Nereus & Achilles, died end of 1st century; Pope St. Damasus states that they were Praetorian soldiers who converted to Christianity; their *acta* report that they were beheaded during the reign of Trajan. Pancras, died c. 304; his "acts" state that he was a Syrian or Phrygian orphan who came to Rome where he was converted to Christianity; he was beheaded under Diocletian in his 14th year; buried on the Via Aurelia. **Wed., Our Lady of Fatima:** Our Lady of Fatima is venerated under this title following the apparitions to 3 shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. The message of Fatima includes a call to conversion of heart, repentance from sin, & prayer, especially the Rosary. **Thurs., St. Matthias, Apostle:** Matthias, died 1st century; chosen to replace Judas; qualified because he witnessed Jesus' ministry & resurrection; said to have suffered martyrdom either at Colchis or in Jerusalem; mentioned in the Roman Canon. **Fri., St. Isidore:** Isidore, died 1130; layman whose wife, Maria de la Cabeza, is also a saint; farm laborer associated with miracles; patron of Madrid, of farmers, & of rural communities. **Sat., Easter Weekday**
