Feast days for the week of May 17th: Mon., St. John I, Pope, martyr: John I, died 526, introduced the Alexandrian computation of the date of Easter; buried in Rome; his epitaph saluted him as "a victim for Christ." Tues., Easter Weekday
Wed., St. Bernardine of Siena, priest: Bernardine, died 1444; O.F.M.; famous reformer & eloquent preacher who traveled throughout Italy; encouraged devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus; known for his use of the monogram, *IHS* (an abbreviation of the Greek name for Jesus); patron of advertisers & advertising; invoked against hoarseness. Thurs., St. Christopher Magallanes, priest, & Companions, martyrs: Christopher Magallanes & 21 diocesan priests & 3 laymen were either shot or hanged († 1915-1937) for their association with the *Cristero* uprising which opposed the anti-Catholic Mexican government in the 1920's. The *Cristero* motto was, "Long live Christ the King & the Virgin of Guadalupe!" Fri., St. Rita of Cascia, religious: Rita was born in 1381 in Umbria. She lived with a brutal husband & had 2 sons. After the violent murder of her husband, she urged forgiveness in contrast to the customary vendetta of her day. Becoming an Augustinian nun, she spent some 40 years in prayer, contemplation, & service to the sick & poor. Toward the end of her life, she received a wound from a thorn from the crown of thorns. She died in 1457. Patron saint of desperate situations. Sat., Easter Weekday
