Feast days for the week of May 24th: Mon., St. Bede the Venerable, Priest, Doctor of the Church; St. Gregory VII, Pope; St. Mary Magdalene de'Pazzi, Virgin: Bede, died 735; called "Venerable" while still living. Gregory VII, died 1085; championed reform of the clergy against simony, clerical marriage & lay investiture, leading to the excommunication of Henry IV. Mary Magdalene de'Pazzi, died 1607; Carmelite mystic of Florence who led a hidden life of prayer & self-denial, praying particularly for the renewal of the Church & encouraging her fellow sisters in holiness. **Tues., St. Philip Neri, priest:** Philip Neri, died 1595; founded the Congregation of Priests of the Oratory, today numbering about 527 members, to promote holiness of priestly life & foster effective preaching. **Wed., St. Augustine of Canterbury, Bishop:** Augustine, died 604; ordained bishop in 597; in 601, received the pallium as Primate of England. **Thurs., Easter Weekday Fri., St. Paul VI, Pope:** Ordained in 1920; during World War II, worked to find shelter for persecuted Jews & refugees; immediately after being elected pope in 1963, he continued the work begun by his predecessors & brought the Second Vatican Council to its completion. **Sat., Easter Weekday Pentecost Sunday:** Acts 2:1-11 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 Jn 20:19-23
