Feast days for the week of May 31st: **Mon., The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church:** In 2018, Pope Francis decreed that the memorial of the “Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church” be inscribed in the General Roman Calendar & observed on the Monday after Pentecost. The joyous veneration given to the Mother of God by the contemporary Church, in light of reflection on the mystery of Christ & on His nature, cannot ignore the figure of a woman, the Virgin Mary, who is both the Mother of Christ and the Mother of the Church. **Tues., Sts. Marcellinus & Peter, martyrs:** Marcellinus, presbyter, & Peter, exorcist, died c. 303; beheaded under Diocletian; both mentioned in the Roman Canon. **Wed., St. Charles Lwanga & Companions, martyrs:** Charles Lwanga & 21 Ugandan Companions, died Nov. 15, 1885 - Jan. 27, 1887; proto-martyrs of Black Africa; over 100 killed in this period, including Anglicans; Charles is the patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action. **Thurs., Weekday Fri., St. Boniface, bishop, martyr:** Boniface, died 754; Anglo-Saxon O.S.B.; founded abbey of Fulda; bishop of Mainz; martyred along with 30 companions at Dokkum in Frisia; known as the “Apostle of Germany.” **Sat., St. Norbert, bishop:** Norbert, died 1134; founded the Premonstratensians or “Norbertines,” today numbering some 1,200 members; archbishop of Magdeburg; strong supporter of Church reform & evangelization; devoted to the Holy Eucharist. **Most Holy Trinity Sunday:** Ex 34:4b-6, 8-9 2 Cor 13:11-13 Jn 3:16-18

Happy birthday to the Catholic Church! Happy birthday to you, who are the body of the Church!

We're all familiar with our own birthdays, and we celebrate them because they mark the day of the year in which we entered into this life. But did you know you have a second birthday?

Because you are part of the body of the Church, Pentecost is the Church's birthday, and yours as well. And like any birth-day, it's a cause for celebration.

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and their followers, and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations. Pentecost is also a Jewish holiday, which the Jews use to celebrate the end of Passover. Jews celebrate the gift of the law to Moses at Mt. Sinai on this day. But we, as Catholics celebrate the birth of our Church.
