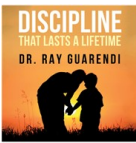

Feast days for week of Dec. 27th: Mon., The Holy Innocents, martyrs
Tues., St. Thomas Becket, Bishop, Martyr: Thomas Becket, died 1170; killed by order of Henry II; as archbishop of Canterbury defended the freedoms of the Church; canonized only 3 years after his death; considered the most famous martyr of the Middle Ages. Wed., Sixth Day within the Octave of the Nativity of the Lord Thurs., St. Sylvester I, Pope: Sylvester, died 335; as bishop of Rome [314-335], organized public worship & dedicated the Lateran basilica; represented at the Council of Nicea which condemned Arianism; one of the 1st non-martyrs venerated as a saint. Fri., Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God Sat., Sts. Basil the Great & Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops, Doctors of the Church: Basil, died Jan. 1, 379; hermit who became bishop of Caesarea in Cappadocia; wrote a rule on monasticism; source of Eucharistic Prayer IV; along with Sts. Gregory Nazianzen, Athanasius, & John Chrysostom, considered one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church. Gregory Nazianzen, died Jan. 25, 389 or 390; Patriarch of Constantinople; called *theologus* for his outstanding teaching abilities & eloquence. Epiphany of the Lord: Is 60:1-6 Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6 Mt 2:1-12
