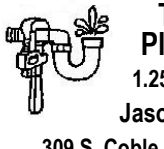

Feast days for week of Jan. 31st: Mon., Weekday Tues., The Presentation of the Lord Wed., St. Blaise, Bishop, Martyr; St. Ansgar, Bishop: Blaise, martyred in the persecution of Licinius, early 4th c.; bishop of Sebaste in Armenia; associated with the healing of throats; venerated as well by Eastern Church. Ansgar, died 865 at Bremen; O.S.B. missionary to Denmark & Sweden; bishop of Hamburg; great preacher & administrator; known as the "Apostle of the North"; patron of Denmark, Germany, & Iceland. **Thurs., Weekday Fri., St. Agatha, virgin, martyr:** Agatha, died probably under Decius (c. 251) in Sicily; patroness of Palermo & Catania; invoked for protection against volcanic eruptions & fires; mentioned in the Roman Canon. **Sat., St. Paul Miki & Companions, Martyrs:** Paul Miki, Jesuit scholastic, & his 25 companions, including 2 other Jesuits, 6 Franciscans, 15 tertiaries, & 2 laymen, were crucified by order of the ruler Hideyoshi in 1597 at Nagasaki; among them, the Mexican, Felipe de Jesus, 1st martyr from the Americas to be beatified; proto-martyrs of the Far East (canonized in 1862 by Pope Pius IX.) **5th Sunday in Ordinary Time:** Jb 7:1-4, 6-7 1 Cor 9:16-19, 22-23 Mk 1:29-39
