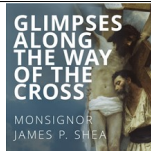

Fast and Abstain from meat on Good Friday!

All Catholics who are 14 years of age & older are obliged to abstain from eating meat. All Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years are obliged to limiting oneself to one full meal. Two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Also, eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
