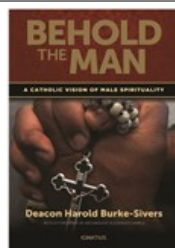

Feast days for week of June 27th: Mon., St. Irenaeus, bishop, martyr: Irenaeus, died c. 202; from Smyrna; disciple of St. Polycarp; bishop of Lyons for 25 years; first to provide a coherent rationale for a Christian Bible including both testaments, & the first to offer a comprehensive account of belief in God's universal providential & redemptive economy. **Tues., Sts. Peter & Paul, Apostles:** Peter, died c. 64 in Rome under Nero; Galilean fisherman; spokesman for the Twelve who became "Prince of the Apostles"; two epistles are ascribed to him; patron of those in the fishing industry. Paul was martyred in Rome c. 67; Pharisee who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles"; his letters may be dated from c. 50-65; patron of the lay apostolate, the Cur-sillo Movement, & Catholic Action; also Malta & Greece. **Wed., The 1st Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church**

Thurs., St. Junipero Serra, priest: Junipero Serra, died 1784; from Petra, Majorca, Spain; O.F.M. missionary who arrived in New Spain in 1750; established nine of the California missions; baptized over 6,000 native peoples; recognized as a builder of the state of California; "an exemplary model of the selfless evangelizer" (Pope John Paul II). **Fri., Weekday** **Sat., St. Thomas, apostle:** Thomas, died 1st century; his doubting gave way to faith when he saw the risen Lord; associated with founding the Church in south India; mentioned in the Roman Canon; patron of builders, India, & Pakistan. **14th Sunday in Ordinary**
