Feast days for week of July 4th: Mon., St. Anthony Zaccaria, priest; St. Elizabeth of Portugal: Anthony Zaccaria, died 1539; doctor turned priest; founded the Clerics Regular of St. Paul; today number some 380 members. Elizabeth, died 1336; named after her great-aunt, St. Elizabeth of Hungary; queen & mother; lover of the poor. Tues., St. Maria Goretti, Virgin, Martyr: Maria Goretti, died 1902 at age 12; stabbed to death, preferring to die than be raped; canonized in 1950 before the largest crowd ever assembled at that time in Rome for a canonization; patroness of teenage girls. Wed., Weekday Thurs., Weekday Fri., St. Augustine Zhao Rong, priest, & Companions, martyrs: 120 martyrs died between 1648 & 1930. Most born in China, children, parents, catechists, or laborers, from 9 years old to 72, includes 4 Chinese priests. 33 foreign-born were mostly priests or women religious. Augustine Zhao Rong was a Chinese soldier who accompanied the prisoner Bishop John Gabriel Taurin Dufresse to his martyrdom in Beijing. Moved by the Bishop's courage, Augustine sought baptism & not long after was ordained a diocesan priest, martyred in 1815. Beatified in groups at various times, canonized in 2000 by Pope John Paul II. Sat., Week-day 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Am 7:12-15 Eph 1:3-14 Mk 6:7-13

Bebak, Allow me to acknowledge receipt of the letter of June 8, 2021, signed by yourself and Parishioners of Holy Family Parish. Thank you for taking the time to write and share your concerns. The requests expressed in your letter regarding Holy Communion are acknowledged. As you are likely aware, in the time since your letter, the USCCB has held its June General Assembly. During the meeting, the Bishops voted to authorize the drafting of a document on the Meaning of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church; this document is expected to be drafted by the November 2021 USCCB meeting. It is believed and hoped that you and your co-authors may be satisfied with this result. This opportunity is taken to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers. Sincerely yours in Christ, *Frank J.
