Feast days for week of July 18th: Mon., Weekday Tues., St. Apollinaris, bishop, martyr: Apollinaris, died 1st century; ordained by St. Peter & sent as a missionary bishop to Ravenna during the reign of the emperor Claudius. Renowned for his power to heal in the name of Christ, he was frequently exiled, tortured, & imprisoned for the faith, & finally martyred. Wed., St. Lawrence of Brindisi, priest, doctor of the Church: Lawrence, died 1619; Capuchin, linguist, military chaplain, diplomat & minister general; learned exegete, forceful preacher, & controversialist; 15 volumes of his writings are extant. Thurs., St. Mary Magdalene: Mary Magdalene, died 1st c.; healed of possession; disciple of Jesus & present at His crucifixion; in Mark, the first to witness to the risen Lord (hence, called the "apostle of the Apostles"); patroness of Order of Preachers. Fri., St. Bridget, religious: Bridget, died 1373; born in Sweden; fought to return pope to Rome; mystic prophet & foundress of Order of the Most Holy Savior; patroness of Sweden, co-patroness of Europe. Sat., St. Sharbel Makhlof, priest: Sharbel Makhlof, died 1898; became a monk of the Maronite Rite & was ordained a priest in 1859. Canonized in 1977.

FR. KAPAUN'S REMAINS will be in Pilsen Sat., Sept. 25—Mon., Sept. 27. The remains will fly from Honolulu, Hawaii, to the Wichita airport on Sept. 25. From the airport, a procession of dignitaries and motorcycles will drive directly to Pilsen, hopefully arriving early afternoon. The estimated mile-long motorcade will be escorted by the Sheriff Departments of the county that it is passing through, with handoffs from one to the other occurring at the county lines. Traffic will be stopped as the procession turns onto Highway 56, and also onto Remington Road. After his remains are brought into St. John Nep. Church, there will be a short prayer service welcoming him home, and then the dignitaries leave. From this point until his remains leave on Mon., Sept 27 at noon, is for the Pilsen people to spend time with Fr. Kapaun. This is why Pilsen events are not being published by the diocese. Plans are being made by the parish in many different areas, from sacramental events [adoration, rosaries, prayer services, etc.] to security to parking to sprucing up the church/grounds/museum.
