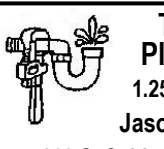
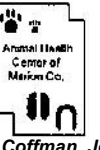

Feast days for week of Sept 12th: Mon., St. John Chrysostom, bishop, doctor of the Church: John Chrysostom, died 407; ascetic; became bishop of Constantinople; outstanding preacher (thus named "golden mouthed"); defended the poor; sought reform of the clergy; twice exiled due to royal opposition; one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church; patron of preachers & of Istanbul (Constantinople). Tues., The Exaltation of the Holy Cross Wed., Our Lady of Sorrows: By the 14th Century, the sorrows of Mary were seven: the presentation of Jesus in the Temple; the flight into Egypt; Jesus lost in Jerusalem; the meeting of Mary and Jesus on the way to Calvary; the crucifixion; the taking down of Jesus' body from the cross; & his burial. Thurs., Sts. Cornelius, pope, & Cyprian, bishop, martyrs: Cornelius, died 253 in exile in Civitavecchia; opposed Novatian & the rigorists in the lapsi controversy; buried in the cemetery of Callistus. Cyprian, decapitated 258 under Valerian; ally of Cornelius; bishop of Carthage; 1st African bishop to be martyred; patron of North Africa & of Algeria; both mentioned in Roman Canon. Fri., St. Robert Bellarmine, bishop, doctor of the Church: Robert Bellarmine, died 1621; brilliant Jesuit scholar, preacher, writer, & systematic apologist of the Counter Reformation; cardinal archbishop of Capua; patron of catechists & catechumens. Sat., Weekday 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Wis 2:12, 17-20 Jas 3:16-4:3 Mk 9:30-37

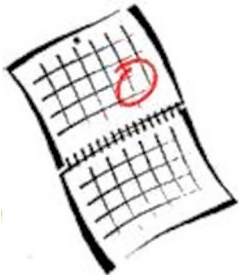
TAMPA PSR Grades 1-8 is meeting on Wednesdays from 7-8:15pm.

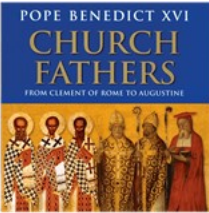

FR. KAPAUN’S HOMECOMING WEEKEND

12:30 – 1:00pm Fr. Kapaun’s remains depart Wichita in motorcade to Pilsen.
1:00pm Legion Riders assemble outside Pilsen.
1:45 – 2:00pm [Approximate time, depends on flight/traffic delays.] Fr. Kapaun’s remains arrive, escorted into Pilsen and then the Church. Short prayer service to follow. Fr Kapaun lies in state in the front of church in a closed coffin for the remainder of the weekend. Viewing open to everyone.
9:00pm - Sun., 9:00am Adoration – Please sign up for your spot.

The Diocese is reserving these days for Pilsen and the Holy Family Parish community and is downplaying anyone else attending to mitigate the numbers and to allow Father’s people to say goodbye. A documentary film crew will be present at the arrival of Father’s remains and during Mass to record video footage of Fr. Kapaun’s final visit to Pilsen.

Florence and Marion weekend Masses will be held at the regularly scheduled time.

HOME AT LAST T-SHIRTS:

The return home of the remains of our native son, Chaplain Emil J. Kapaun, is a once in a lifetime event. To commemorate and celebrate this historical moment, special limited edition t-shirts are being sold.
