Feast days for week of Sept 19th: Mon., Sts. Andrew Kim Tae-gon, priest, & Paul Chong Ha-sang, & Companions, martyrs: Andrew, born in Seoul, Korea, was a convert to the faith & ordained Korea's first native priest. His father was a martyr. In 1846, Andrew was tortured & beheaded along with his lay associate, seminarian Paul Chong Ha-sang. Between 1839 & 1867, 103 martyrs gave their lives for the faith in Korea. Tues., St. Matthew, apostle, evangelist Wed., Weekday Thurs., St. Pius of Pietrelcina, priest: "Padre Pio" was born Francesco Forgione in 1887 in the small Italian village of Pietrelcina. A Capuchin priest who had received the stigmata, he spent 50 years at the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo, where he was much sought after as a spiritual advisor, confessor, & intercessor. Despite such notoriety, he would often say, "I only want to be a poor friar who prays." Devoted to the Eucharist & to prayer, he died Sept. 23, 1968, at age 81. FR. KAPAUN’S HOMECOMING WEEKEND
SCHEDULE for Sept. 25-27, 2021

Sat., Sept. 25th:
12:30 – 1:00pm Fr. Kapaun’s remains depart Wichita in motorcade to Pilsen.
1:00pm Legion Riders assemble outside Pilsen.
1:45 – 2:00pm [Approximate time, depends on flight/traffic delays.] Fr. Kapaun’s remains arrive, escorted into Pilsen and then the Church. Short prayer service to follow. Fr Kapaun lies in state in the front of church in a closed coffin for the remainder of the weekend. Viewing open to everyone.

A documentary film crew will be present at the arrival of Father’s remains and during Mass to record video footage of Fr. Kapaun’s final visit to Pilsen.

The Sat., Sept. 25th Mass will be in Pilsen at 5pm. Florence will not have a Mass this weekend.
Marion Sunday Mass will be held at the regularly scheduled time of 8:30am.

HOME AT LAST T-SHIRTS: The return home of the remains of our native son, Chaplain Emil J. Kapaun, is a once in a lifetime event. To commemorate and celebrate this historical moment, special limited edition t-shirts are being sold.
