Feast days for week of Nov. 7th: Mon., Weekday Tues.,
The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica Wed., St. St. Leo the
Great, pope, doctor of the Church: Leo, died 461; eminent pastor &
preacher; defender of the Roman primacy; combated Pelagianism &
Manichaeism; his Tome on Christ's 2 natures was adopted by the
Council of Chalcedon; many of his prayers are found in the Roman
Missal; saved Rome from marauding Huns & Vandals. Thurs.,
St. Martin of Tours, bishop: Martin, died 397; from Pannonia (in
Hungary); soldier turned Christian at 18; disciple of St. Hilary; at
Liguge, founded the 1st monastery in the West; bishop of Tours; 1st non-martyr with annual feast in the Western Church; patron of
soldiers, wine producers, & of France. Fri., St. Josaphat, bishop, martyr: Josaphat Kuncevyh, died 1623; born in Poland,
raised Ukranian Orthodox, becoming a Basilian monk of the Ruthenian Rite; bishop of Polotsk; his fidelity to the Roman See & his
desire for union between the Ukranian Church & Rome led to his murder at Vitebsk; 1st formally canonized saint of the Eastern
Rite. Sat., St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, Virgin: Frances Xavier Cabrini, died in Chicago 1917; youngest of 13 children;
founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart; for 28 years labored in U.S. & South America, establishing some 67 institu-
tions (schools, hospitals & orphanages); 1st U.S. citizen canonized; patroness of immigrants & migrants.
