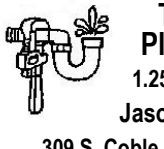
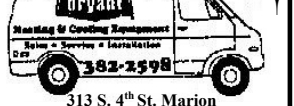

Feast days for week of Dec. 12th: Mon., St. Lucy, virgin, martyr: Lucy, died in Sicily c. 304 under Diocletian; because of her name, she is the patroness of those afflicted with diseases of the eye & associated with festivals of light, especially in Scandinavia; mentioned in the Roman Canon; patroness of Syracuse & all Sicily. **Tues., John of the Cross, Priest, Doctor of the Church:** John of the Cross, died 1591; born in Spain c. 1542; mystic & poet; ally of Teresa of Jesus of Avila in founding the reformed ("Discalced") Carmelite friars; suffered imprisonment by the unreformed Carmelites; authored *The Dark Night of the Soul*, and other books; known as the "Mystical Doctor"; Discalced Carmelites today number around 4,000 religious.
