Feast days for week of Jan. 2nd: Mon., The Most Holy Name of Jesus Tues., St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Religious: Elizabeth Ann Bayley Seton, died 1821; raised Episcopalian; wife & mother of 5 children; foundress of the 1st congregation for women religious in USA, the Sisters of Charity, devoted primarily to the education of the poor & to teaching in parochial schools; 1st native-born citizen canonized. Wed., St. John Neumann, Bishop: John Neumann, died 1860; missionary from Bohemia; C.S.S.R.; bishop of Philadelphia; known for his holiness & learning; promoter of parochial schools; authored 2 German catechisms; 1st American bishop canonized. Thurs., St. Andre Bessette, religious: Frere Andre, died Jan. 6, 1937 at age 91; C.S.C.; orphaned at age 12; known as a healer & the “Miracle Man of Montreal” where he founded the Oratory of St. Joseph to whom he was dedicated & fostered devotion; over one million people paid their respects at his death; patron of caregivers Fri., St. Raymond of Penyafort, priest: Raymond of Penafort, died 1275 at age 99; O.P.; second master general after St. Dominic; collator of canon law; noted work on penance; patron of canonists & lawyers. 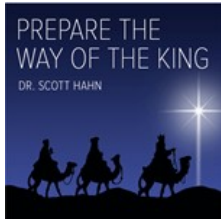
