Feast days for week of Jan. 23rd: Mon., St. Francis de Sales, bishop, doctor of the Church: Francis de Sales, died 1622; bishop of Geneva; sought to bring many back to the Church through his personal life & writings, especially his *Controversies* & several devout treatises, including his *Introduction to the Devout Life*; co-founder with St. Jane Frances de Chantal of the Visitation Order; patron of writers, journalists, & the deaf. Tues., The Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle
Wed., Sts. Timothy & Titus, bishops: Timothy, from Lystra in Asia Minor, & Titus, of Greek origin, died 1st century; companions of St. Paul & overseers of the churches of Ephesus & Crete, respectively; recipients of the so-called pastoral epistles. Thurs., St. Angela Merici, virgin: Angela Merici, died 1540 at Brescia; orphaned at ten; foundress of the Ursulines, the first teaching Order especially for poor young girls; sought re-evangelization of families through the education of future wives & mothers. Fri., St. Thomas Aquinas, priest, doctor of the Church: Thomas Aquinas, died 1274; O.P.; the “Angelic Doctor” who wrote the *Summa Theologiae* and authored *Adoro te devote*, *O salutaris*, *Tantum ergo*, and *Pange lingua*; patron of Catholic schools, colleges, & universities, of philosophers, theologians, & booksellers. Chaplain Kapaun Tours

Musings of a Docent - Melissa Stuchlik, wife of Christopher

As a docent at the Chaplain (Capt.) Kapaun museum, one of my own personal favorite moments is when I am giving a tour and they walk into our church for the very first time. I remember that moment for me. On one of our early dates, I came to Marion County to go out with Christopher. We attended his church for Mass before going out on that Saturday night. Mass was late in the evening, something I didn’t have in Wichita. I stepped into St. John Nepomucene (it would be a while before I said it correctly) and it was a moment that took my breath away. Built in the Gothic style, the cost and dedication of the parishioners who built it is in every detail. It didn’t take long before I heard stories of St. John’s history from each parishioner I met. For Christopher, his family called this church home for 3 generations. We would be married in that church by the same priest who had baptized him as a baby. Even though he grew up there, and his great-uncle working on the steeple is one of his favorite stories to share, he didn’t know the history of the building or the two before it.

We share the history of the buildings (or bits of it) at tours. As a parishioner of Holy Family Parish, has your family attended one of these tours? Did you know that the steeple is 111 feet from the ground to the copper shingled roof? That the cross is gold-gilded and over 7 feet tall and 4 ½ feet wide? When you hear the bells before Mass, did you know there are 3 of them and one weighs 2,000 pounds? The cost of the 3 altars and the 14 Stations of the Cross was \$3,000. The parishioners came in and hand-dug that basement to put in buttresses that were sturdy enough to hold up the 30 foot walls. Those basement walls are 26 inches thick but the ones that hold up that tower are 32 inches thick. They lined the outside of those cement walls with native ashlar stone. This church was built to last!

All this and more are part of the history of your church. Drop in on Tuesdays or Fridays from 1-4pm. We can also do private tours. We look forward to sharing stories about your church. Check us out on Facebook at Chaplain Kapaun Museum, Pilsen, KS.
