Feast days for week of Feb. 6th: Mon., Weekday Tues., St. Jerome Emiliani; St. Josephine Bakhita, virgin:
 Jerome Emiliani, died 1537 of the plague; Venetian soldier whose conversion led to the founding of the Clerks Regular of
 Somascha, today numbering about 600 members; dedicated to the poor & the education of youth; patron of orphans & aban-
 doned children. Josephine was born around 1869 in Sudan & raised in the Islamic faith. She was kidnapped around the
 age of 7 by slave traders who gave her the name “Bakhita” meaning “lucky one.” She was eventually purchased by an Ital-
 ian, was baptized, granted her freedom, and joined the Canossian Daughters of Charity. Pope John Paul II canonized this
 1st Sudanese saint as a model of freedom. **Wed., Weekday Thurs., St. Scholastica, virgin:** Scholastica,
 died c. 543 at Monte Cassino; twin sister of St. Benedict; “She could do more because she loved more” (St. Gregory the
 Great, *The Dialogues*); eventually interred in the same grave with her brother; invoked against storms; patroness of Benedic-
 tine nunneries. **Fri., Our Lady of Lourdes:** Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous at Lourdes, France, in 1858,
 and proclaimed herself “the Immaculate Conception.” Our Lady of Lourdes is the patroness of Portugal & the Philippines.

CREATIVE CONTRIBUTIONS: As you can see on the front page, last weekend’s contribution amount is significantly higher than usual. There are 2 reasons for this. One is the case of a parishioner donating stock to the church, which was then sold. This obviously benefits our parish, but also resulted in tax savings for this parishioner in more than one way. Also, as happened last year, parishioners are taking advantage of the tax benefits of donating to a qualified charity [i.e., Holy Family Parish] directly from their IRA. This is called a “Qualified Charitable Distribution,” or QCD. It must be shown separately on the end-of-year tax donation statement, so please let the church office know if you are donating a QCD. No taxes are withheld on a QCD, whereas when you give out of your checking account, you are donating taxed income. By filling out special paperwork and giving a lump sum once a year directly from an IRA, income taxes are avoided. You must be 70 1/2 years old to make a QCD, which counts toward your required minimum distribution for the year. Be sure to ask your accountant if this would benefit you.

VALUE THEM BOTH: On August 2nd, we will have our chance to protect women and babies in Kansas by voting in favor of the VALUE THEM BOTH Amendment to our state constitution. *Flyers with more information are in the back of our churches.* VALUE THEM BOTH will allow us to:

- Protect current Kansas law, which prevents babies from being aborted up to the moment of birth.
- Prevent taxpayer-funded abortion and extreme procedures such as partial-birth and live-dismemberment abortions.
- Preserve safeguards that require the abortion industry to protect women with important clinic health and safety standards.

The abortion industry will pour millions into our state in an attempt to mislead voters. We must show them that the people of Kansas VALUE THEM BOTH. Vote YES on August 2, 2022.
