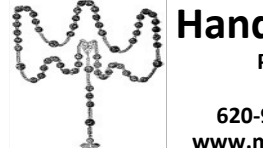
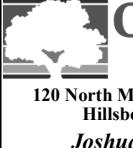
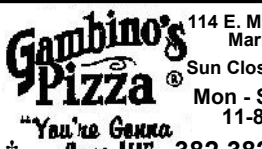

**Mon., St. Robert Bellarmine, bishop, doctor of the Church:** Robert Bellarmine, died 1621; Tuscan; brilliant Jesuit scholar, preacher, writer, & systematic apologist of the Counter Reformation; cardinal archbishop of Capua; patron of catechists & catechumens. **Tues., Weekday**

**Wed., St. Januarius, bishop, martyr:** Januarius, died c. 305; bishop of Benevento; as early as 1389, his blood has liquefied on this & other days each year; patron of Naples. **Thur., Sts. 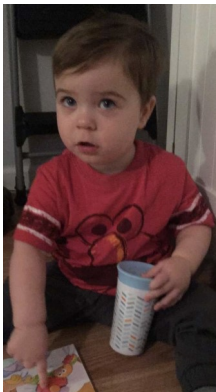

## FROM THE Pastor's Desk

### The Seven Sorrows of Our Lady Feastday Sept. 15th

The feast of the Seven Sorrows or MAIN Sorrows of Mary (often referred to as the Seven Dolors) is a memorial that is kept twice yearly: the Friday before Good Friday in Lent, and again on Sept. 15th.

We must never forget the Cross of Christ by which we are redeemed, and the Sorrows of His Mother and our mother, who anguished with Him for us. We concentrate on the sufferings of both Jesus and Mary during Lent. Again during the long season of Ordinary Time—in order that we might not forget the Cross and its sorrow and meaning—the Church has established the feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, observed on Sept. 14th, and the Feast of the Seven Sorrows of Mary on the day after, symbolically placing Mary as she was historically, at the foot of the Cross.

The Seven Sorrows of Mary are:

1. The Presentation of Jesus as an Infant at the Temple, and Simeon's fearful prophecy to Mary: "and thine own soul a sword shall pierce."
2. The hurried Flight of the Holy Family into Egypt to escape King Herod's murderous wrath.
3. The three day loss of Jesus in the Temple.
4. The Way of the Cross, particularly the meeting of the Son and the Mother (4th Station).
5. The nailing of Jesus to the Cross.
6. The taking down of the lifeless body of Jesus from the Cross and receiving it in her arms.
7. The Burial of Jesus. The door closing upon her Son.

Every Catholic should practice a tender devotion to the Seven Sorrows of Mary, His Spiritual Mother. Everyone should do at least this daily: think of each of the Sorrows, and after considering each, say a Hail Mary, then: "*Mary, sorrowing Mother of Christians, pray for us.*" Or at the very least the invocation: "*Mary, sorrowing Mother of Christians, pray for us.*" ~ The Observer

**Catholic Youth Ministry (CYM)** for High School will meet in MAC on the 1st Wednesday of each month, 7:00-8:30 pm.

**"ALL SCHOOL PSR MASS"** is a new twist from the way we've previously celebrated PSR Masses. There will be 5 Masses for PSR students from all sites throughout the year, with the location rotating. There will be no classes held on these nights. Fr. Bebak will be available for Confessions 20 minutes before Mass. All students & teachers from ALL sites are expected to attend these special Masses for the spiritual benefit of our catechists and PSR students. Students sit with their family. All parishioners are also invited, as the morning Mass will be cancelled.

**CHANGES TO 1ST COMMUNION PROGRAM:** First Communion and First Confession preparation will no longer be a two-year program, but will be completed during the second grade. First Confession for all children will be held on Sat., May 4, 2019 at the Marion church at 9am, followed by First Communion practice. First Communion will be held on Sun., May 5, 2019 at Marion and Pilsen.
