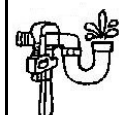

formation are in the back of our churches.*

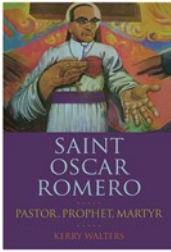

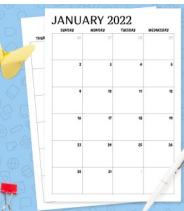
