Feast days for week of June 19th: Mon., Weekday Tues., St. Aloysius Gonzaga, religious; Aloysius Gonzaga, Jesuit scholastic, died 1591 at age 23 caring for the sick; from the princely family of Castiglione; renounced inheritance to enter the Jesuits; St. Robert Bellarmine was his spiritual director; strongly devoted to the Eucharist, interior prayer, & charitable service; patron of youth & of students in Jesuit colleges & universities. Wed., St. Paulinus of Nola, Bishop; Sts. John Fisher, Bishop, & Thomas More, Martyrs: Paulinus, died 431; husband & father who gave his possessions to the poor; dedicated bishop, especially during the Visigoth invasions. John Fisher, beheaded 1535; bishop of Rochester; renowned for his preaching & educational reforms; defender of Church tradition against Luther, & of the Roman primacy against Henry VIII. Thomas More, beheaded 1535; humanist & chancellor of England; wrote Utopia; refused to support Henry VIII's divorce of Queen Catherine & his Act of Supremacy; patron of lawyers, statesmen, & politicians. 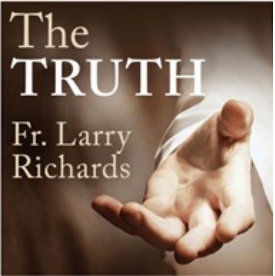

Pro-Life Answers to False Pro-Choice Arguments

"If abortion is outlawed, women would be forced to have unsafe back-alley abortions."

For years, the abortion industry has concocted statistics to frighten people into supporting their agenda. The fact is that every study ever conducted (including figures released by the pro-choice Alan Guttmacher Institute) proves that so-called "back-alley abortions" were extremely rare, prior to abortion being legalized in 1973.

Moreover, the idea that women would be forced to have unsafe "back-alley abortions" if abortion was again illegal, has now been discredited by an actual "test market", so to speak. For 44 years under Nazi and then Communist rule, abortions were legal in Poland. In 1993, the new freely elected Parliament passed a law forbidding abortion. The media screamed: "You will not stop abortions; they will just go underground and women will be injured and die and there will be a flood of miscarriages."

However, the law was passed and not only did abortions drop precipitously (from around 138,000 to 99 per annum), but none of the ominous predictions of the pro-choice lobby materialized. In fact, quite the reverse is true. Miscarriages dropped from around 59,076 in 1990 to 41,568 in 1999. Deaths due to pregnancy and birth dropped from 70 to 24 and neonatal deaths per 1,000 live births dropped from 19 to 9.

Not only did none of the dire predictions materialize, but instead, Polish women are healthier and have fewer gynecological problems than when abortion was legal and common. So here we have a modern, western nation of 40 million people that decided to forbid abortion by law. The result shatters and completely destroys the long-standing pro-abortion argument about "back-alley" abortions.

We pray that society will see that it cannot love women while killing their children, and cannot save children without helping their mothers.
We pray that people will be touched by the pro-life question,
“Why can’t we love them both?”

VALUE THEM BOTH: On August 2nd, we will have our chance to protect women and babies in Kansas by voting YES for the VALUE THEM BOTH Amendment to our state constitution. VALUE THEM BOTH will allow us to:

- Protect current Kansas law, which prevents babies from being aborted up to the moment of birth.
- Prevent taxpayer-funded abortion and extreme procedures such as partial-birth and live-dismemberment abortions.
- Preserve safeguards that require the abortion industry to protect women with important clinic health and safety standards.

The abortion industry will pour millions into our state in an attempt to mislead voters. We must show them that the people of Kansas VALUE THEM BOTH.

ATTENTION: This amendment will be decided based on the voting done at **the primary on August 2nd**. It is critical that everyone vote in the primary as this will **NOT** be on the ballot in November!! The deadline to register to vote in the primary is July 12th at 5pm at the courthouse. This is our only chance! Also — for those who are unaffiliated with a political party, you will only be able to vote on issues, such as the Value Them Both Amendment. Although you are not choosing the person of your party [Republican, Democrat, or Libertarian] to appear on the ballot in November, you can still vote! **Every single vote counts!**
