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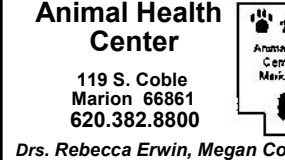
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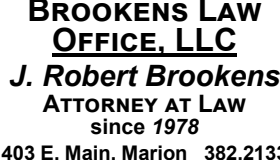

Feast days for week of June 26th: Mon., St. Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop, Doctor of the Church: Cyril, died 444; defended Mary as “God-bearer” at the Council of Ephesus against the Nestorians. Tues., St. Irenaeus, bishop, martyr: Irenaeus, died c. 202; disciple of St. Polycarp; bishop of Lyons for 25 years; first to provide a coherent rationale for a Christian Bible including both testaments, & the first to offer a comprehensive account of belief in God’s universal providential & redemptive economy. Wed., Sts. Peter & Paul, Apostles: Peter, died c. 64 in Rome under Nero; Galilean fisherman; spokesman for the Twelve who became “Prince of the Apostles”; two epistles are ascribed to him; patron of those in the fishing industry. Paul was martyred in Rome c. 67; Pharisee who became the “Apostle of the Gentiles”; his letters may be dated from c. 50-65; patron of the lay apostolate, the Cursillo Movement, & Catholic Action; also Malta & Greece. Thurs., The 1st Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church Fri., St. Junipero Serra, priest: Junipero Serra, died 1784; from Spain; O.F.M. missionary who arrived in New Spain in 1750; established 9 of the California missions; baptized over 6,000 native peoples; recognized as a builder of California; “an exemplary model of the selfless evangelizer”. VALUE THEM BOTH: On August 2nd, we will have our chance to protect women and babies in Kansas by voting YES for the VALUE THEM BOTH Amendment to our state constitution. VALUE THEM BOTH will allow us to:
