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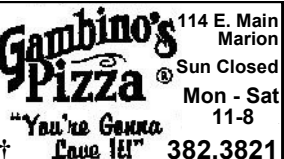

Feast days for week of July 10th: Mon., St. Benedict, abbot: Benedict, died 547; wrote famous monastic Rule noted for its wisdom & moderation & need for obedience: "Let all follow the Rule as their guide in everything, & let no one rashly depart from it." Founded 12 monasteries; Benedictines today number some 7,500 religious; considered the "Patriarch of Western Monasticism"; a patron of Europe. **Tues., Weekday**
Wed., St. Henry: Henry II, died 1024; together with his wife, St. Cunegunda, assisted the poor; as emperor, he respected the Church's freedom, fostering ecclesiastical & monastic reform; founded the See of Bamberg as a center for missions to the Slavs; patron of Benedictine oblates.
Thurs., St. Kateri Tekakwitha, virgin: Kateri, died 1680, at age 24 in Quebec; led a life of great austerity & love in spite of ridicule & abuse; called "Lily of the Mohawks"; first native American to be declared "Blessed" [1980]; canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2012.
Fri., St. Bonaventure, bishop, doctor of the Church: Bonaventure, died 1274; Cardinal bishop of Albano; authored biblical commentaries & many ascetical & spiritual treatises; known as the "Seraphic Doctor."

Pro-Life Answers to False Pro-Choice Arguments

"Women cannot be free unless they have the right to control their own reproductive lives".

There are still many pro-choice advocates who believe that a woman's right to abortion is part of an ongoing feminist struggle for equality and freedom and any restriction on abortion is threatening to women. This sad and regressive mindset is epitomized by Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg. When the Supreme Court recently upheld the ban on the gruesome partial birth abortion procedure, Justice Ginsburg wrote quite an astonishing dissenting opinion.

According to Ginsburg, the right to life of the unborn baby is completely ignored and subordinated to the interest of women having complete autonomy over their "reproductive decisions". In her view, if women do not have this autonomy, they are relegated to "when women were regarded as the center of home and family life with attendant special responsibilities that precluded full and independent legal status under the Constitution." In other words, a woman's right to abort her baby in the womb is central to her life and essential to her being a complete woman.

It is indeed hard to understand the depraved concept that a woman cannot be a real woman unless she has complete autonomy to direct a doctor to abort her own baby, even in the case of a partial birth abortion, when that baby is partially delivered for the purpose of killing it.

The truth of course is that abortion is not about controlling reproduction. When a woman is pregnant, it is a biological reality that reproduction has already taken place. Abortion is about taking the life of the child that has been produced and is alive.

What kind of perverted mind sees the right to abort one's own offspring as a symbol of freedom? As pro-life feminist Frederica Mathewes-Green once wrote, women have abortions for the same reason an animal will gnaw off its own leg to get out of a trap. She pointed out that abortion is not a sign that women are free, but proof that they are desperate.

VALUE THEM BOTH: On August 2nd, we will have our chance to protect women and babies in Kansas by voting YES for the VALUE THEM BOTH Amendment to our state constitution. The abortion industry will pour millions into our state in an attempt to mislead voters. THERE ARE ALREADY TV COMMERCIALS THAT ARE NOT TELLING THE TRUTH! The amendment does NOT abolish abortion. The people of Kansas do VALUE THEM BOTH.
