It is easy to find truth,
though it is hard to face it,
and harder still to follow it.

Feast days for week of Sept. 11th: Mon., The Most Holy Name of Mary Tues., St. John Chrysostom, bishop, doctor of the Church: John Chrysostom, died 407; became bishop of Constantinople; outstanding preacher (thus sur-named “golden mouthed”); defended the poor; twice exiled due to royal opposition; one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church; patron of preachers & of Istanbul (Constantinople). Wed., The Exaltation of the Holy Cross Thurs., Our Lady of Sorrows: By the 14th century, the sorrows of Mary were seven: the presentation of Jesus in the Temple; the flight into Egypt; Jesus lost in Jerusalem; the meeting of Mary and Jesus on the way to Calvary; the crucifix-ion; the taking down of Jesus’ body from the cross; & his burial. Fri., Sts. Cornelius, pope, & Cyprian, bishop, mar-tys: Cornelius, died in 253; opposed Novatian & the rigorists in the lapsi controversy. Cyprian, decapitated 258 under Valerian; ally of Cornelius; bishop of Carthage; first African bishop to be martyred; patron of North Africa & of Algeria; both mentioned in the Roman Canon. Sat., St. Robert Bellarmine, bishop, doctor of the Church; St. Hildegard of Bingen, virgin, doctor of the Church: Robert Bellarmine, died 1621; Tuscan; brilliant Jesuit scholar, preacher, writer, & systematic apologist of the Counter Reformation; cardinal archbishop of Capua; patron of catechists & catechumens. Hildegard of Bingen, died 1179, German Benedictine abbess, writer, composer, philosopher, poet, Christian mystic, & visionary. Patron saint of musicians & writers. 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Am 8:4-7 1 Tm 2:1-8 Lk 16:1-13

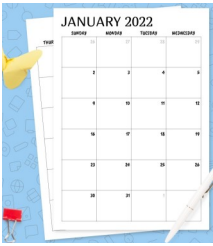
