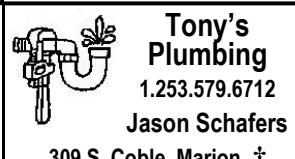

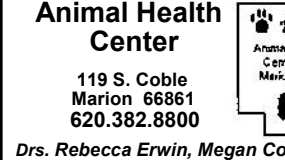

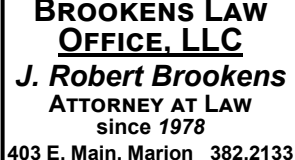

FROM THE
Pastor's Desk

“If the angels were

for two things:
one is the receiving
of Holy Communion,
and the other is suffering.”



Feast days for week of Oct. 2nd: Mon., Weekday Tues., St. Francis of Assisi: Francis, died 1226; noted for his charismatic personality, deep compassion for all, & love for God's creation; renounced wealth to follow “Lady Poverty”; founded the Franciscan Family; wrote *Canticum of the Sun*; received the stigmata; canonized 2 years after his death; patron of ecologists & Italy. Wed., St. Faustina Kowalska, virgin; Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos, priest: Faustina, venerated as the “Apostle of Divine Mercy,” born in Poland in 1905. She professed religious vows to the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Beginning in 1924, and throughout her life, Faustina reported having visions of Jesus and conversations with Him, which she noted in her diary, later published as *The Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska: Divine Mercy in My Soul*. She had a vision of Jesus presenting Himself as “King of Divine Mercy” wearing a white garment with red and pale rays coming from His heart. Canonized in 2000. Born in Germany in 1819, Francis Xavier Seelos entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer & was sent to North America. Served as an assistant pastor under St. John Neumann, later became a full-time itinerant missionary, preaching in both English & German in a number of different states. Declared “Blessed” in 2000. Thurs., St. Bruno, priest; Blessed Marie Rose Durocher, virgin: Bruno, died 1101 in Calabria; celebrated teacher at Reims & close advisor to his former pupil, Pope Urban II; founded the mother house of the Carthusians. Marie-Rose, died 1849 at age 38; born in Quebec; began the 1st Canadian parish sodality for young women; founded the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus & Mary for Christian education. Fri., Our Lady of the Rosary: This Memorial, established by Pope St. Pius V in thanksgiving for the victory at Lepanto, Oct. 7, 1571, recalls the rosary & its meditation on the mysteries of Christ and our salvation. CYM meets the first Wednesday of the month.

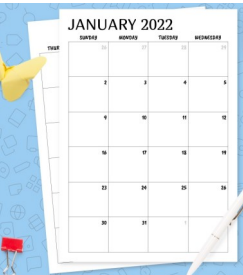
