Feast days for week of Oct. 9th: Mon., Weekday Tues., St. John XXIII, pope: Born of a farming family in northern Italy in 1881, Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was ordained a priest in 1904. As a papal diplomat, helped save an estimated 24,000 Jewish people during World War II. Elected pope in 1958 at age 78, convoked the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), with his feast day being the day of the 1st session of the Council. Canonized by Pope Francis in 2014.
Wed., Weekday Thurs., Weekday Fri., St. Callistus I, pope, martyr: Callistus I, died 222; incurred ire of Tertullian & Hippolytus over lapsi controversy; organized the 1st official Christian cemetery in Rome & instituted Ember Day fasts.
Sat., St. Teresa of Jesus, virgin, doctor of the Church: Teresa of Avila, died 1582 at Alba; Spanish mystic who, with St. John of the Cross, founded the reformed (Disalced) Carmelite friars & nuns, for which she had to endure great trials; authored *Way of Perfection*, *Interior Castle*, & an autobiography; 1st woman declared "Doctor of the Church" (1970); patroness of Spain.

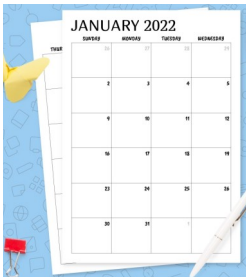
