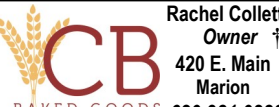
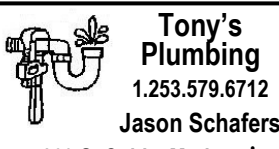
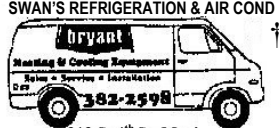

Feast days for week of Oct. 30th: Mon., Weekday Tues., ALL SAINTS Wed., ALL SOULS Thurs., St. Martin de Porres, religious: Martin, died 1639; born in Lima, Peru of a Spanish father & a black slave mother; O.P. lay brother who humbly ministered to the poor & the sick, especially African slaves; devoted to the Eucharist; a close friend of St. Rose of Lima; patron of social justice & of peoples of mixed races. Fri., St. Charles Borromeo, bishop: Charles Borromeo, died 1584 at age 46; cardinal & secretary of state at age 22 for his uncle, Pope Pius IV; implemented reforms of Trent in his diocese of Milan; considered a model pastor by many bishops, including St. Francis de Sales; held 5 provincial councils & 11 diocesan synods; patron of catechists & of catechumens. 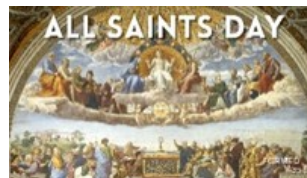

South Korea's Gift of a Chaplain's Helmet



At the completion of the Veteran's Day Mass, Ray Kapaun, nephew of Fr. Emil Kapaun, will present a Chaplain's helmet to the Chaplain Kapaun Museum in Pilsen. This helmet was presented to Raymond Kapaun and his wife, Lee, by the President of South Korea, Moon Jae-in, shortly after he presented the Order of Military Merit medal, posthumously, to Fr. Emil Kapaun. The helmet has a white cross, the symbol of a Chaplain on the front, and it has a bullet hole next to the cross. It was presented to Raymond and his wife, Lee, to show the sacrifices that the soldiers faced as they fought to defend the freedom of South Korea. This helmet shows that many gave their lives to protect those freedoms and that even the Chaplains were targeted during the Korean war.

Immediately after the presentation, everyone will proceed to the Chaplain Kapaun statue on the church grounds for a presentation of a wreath in honor of our military men and women who have sacrificed so much for our freedom. At the completion of the festivities, there will be a luncheon served in the church basement. A suggested donation of \$10 will help support the Altar Society.
