Wed., Dedication of the Lateran Basilica Thurs., St. Leo the Great,
pope, doctor of the Church: Leo, died 461; eminent pastor & preacher; de-
fender of the Roman primacy; combated Pelagianism & Manichaeism; his
Tome on Christ's 2 natures was adopted by the Council of Chalcedon; many
of his prayers are found in the *Roman Missal*; saved Rome from marauding
Huns & Vandals. Fri., St. Martin of Tours, bishop: Martin, died 397; from
Pannonia (in Hungary); soldier turned Christian at 18; disciple of St. Hilary; at
Liguge, founded the 1st monastery in the West; bishop of Tours; 1st non-
martyr with annual feast in the Western Church; patron of soldiers, wine pro-
ducers, & of France. Sat., St. Josaphat, bishop, martyr: Josaphat
Kuncevych, died 1623; born in Poland, raised Ukranian Orthodox, becoming a
Basilian monk of the Ruthenian Rite; bishop of Polotsk; his fidelity to the Ro-
man See & his desire for union between the Ukranian Church & Rome led to
his murder at Vitebsk; 1st formally canonized saint of the Eastern Rite. 33rd

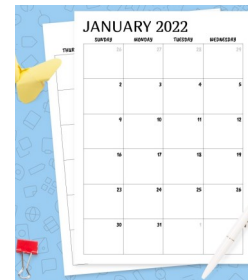
