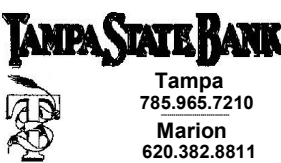

FROM THE
Pastor's Desk

WELCOME to our new pastor, Fr. Isaac Coulter. This is his first pastorship so he is asking for our prayers! His first Mass in the parish will be Wed., Jan. 4th at 8am. He said he is so grateful to be sent here and is looking forward to getting to know everyone!

Feast days for week of Jan. 1st: Mon., Sts. Basil the Great & Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops, Doctors of the Church: Basil, died Jan. 1, 379; hermit who became bishop of Caesarea in Cappadocia; wrote a rule on monasticism; source of Eucharistic Prayer IV; along with Sts. Gregory Nazianzen, Athanasius, & John Chrysostom, considered one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church. Gregory Nazianzen, died Jan. 25, 389 or 390; Patriarch of Constantinople; called *theologus* for his outstanding teaching abilities & eloquence. **Tues., The Most Holy Name of Jesus** **Wed., St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Religious:** Elizabeth Ann Bayley Seton, died 1821; raised Episcopalian; wife & mother of 5 children; foundress of the 1st congregation for women religious in USA, the Sisters of Charity, devoted primarily to the education of the poor & to teaching in parochial schools; 1st native-born citizen canonized. **Thurs., St. John Neumann, Bishop:** John Neumann, died 1860; missionary from Bohemia; C.S.S.R.; bishop of Philadelphia; known for his holiness & learning; promoter of parochial schools; authored 2 German catechisms; 1st American bishop canonized. **Fri., St. Andre Bessette, religious:** Frere Andre, died Jan. 6, 1937 at age 91; C.S.C.; orphaned at age 12; known as a healer & the “Miracle Man of Montreal” where he founded the Oratory of St. Joseph to whom he was dedicated & fostered devotion; over one million people paid their respects at his death; patron of caregivers. **Sat., St. Raymond of Penyafort, priest:** Raymond of Penafort, died 1275 at age 99; O.P.; second master general after St. Dominic; collator of canon law; noted work on penance; patron of canonists & lawyers. **Sun., Epiphany of the Lord:** Is 60:1-6 Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6 Mt 2:1-12
