Feast days for week of Jan. 22nd: Mon., St. Vincent, deacon, martyr; St. Marianne Cope, virgin: Vincent, died c. 304 in persecution of Diocletian at Valencia; patron of wine producers. Marianne Cope, died 1918; a religious of the Sisters of St. Francis of Syracuse, NY; known for her charitable works & virtuous deeds; for 35 years cared for the lepers on the island of Moloka'i; canonized in 2012. **Tues., St. Francis de Sales, bishop, doctor of the Church:** Francis de Sales, died 1622; bishop of Geneva; sought to bring many back to the Church through his personal life & writings, especially his *Controversies* and *Introduction to the Devout Life*; co-founder with St. Jane Frances de Chantal of the Visitation Order; patron of writers, journalists, & the deaf. **Wed., The Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle** Thurs., Sts. Timothy & Titus, bishops: Timothy, from Lystra in Asia Minor, & Titus, of Greek origin, died 1st century; companions of St. Paul & overseers of the churches of Ephesus & Crete, respectively; recipients of the so-called pastoral epistles. **Fri., St. Angela Merici, virgin:** Angela Merici, died 1540; orphaned at ten; foundress of the Ursulines, the first teaching Order especially for poor girls; sought re-evangelization of families through the education of future wives & mothers. **Sat., St. Thomas Aquinas, priest, doctor of the Church:** Thomas Aquinas, died 1274; O.P.; the "Angelic Doctor" who wrote the *Summa Theologiae* and authored *Adoro te devote*, *O salutaris*, *Tantum ergo*, & *Pange lingua*; patron of Catholic schools, colleges, & universities; of philosophers, theologians, & booksellers. **4th Sunday in Ordinary Time:** Zep 2:3; 3:12-13 1 Cor 1:26-31 Mt 5:1-12a

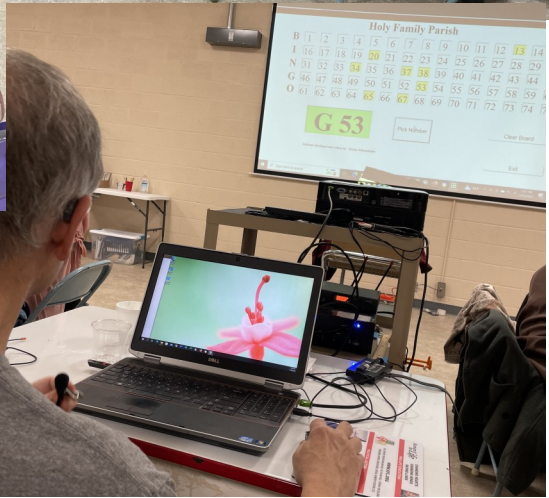
THANK YOU: to all who have donated meat for the Tuesday night burgers with Father, and also to the Marion PSR meals.

A NOTE FROM FR. ISAAC

I'll schedule twice a week to respond to emails and phone calls. Otherwise, hopefully I'm with you or praying. Or organizing stuff for the Sacred Mysteries, get-togethers, and service to our beloved poor.

2. Some resources that help me live life in Christ with his Sacred Scripture:

a) bibleproject.com/explore - The *Tree of Life* and *Water of Life* and *New Humanity* videos are my favorite.

b) singthehours.org -The Liturgy is infinitely more powerful than any other prayer. Regularly singing the Liturgy of the hours has changed me. And there's no better way to pray Sacred Scripture than to pray the Liturgy for that particular day.

c) A way to pray with the Risen One in Scripture

i) Sit up straight and comfortably at your quiet prayer spot at your regular prayer time. Leave your phone in a different room. Set a timer for your dedicated prayer duration (20 minutes).

ii) "Come Holy Spirit. Come through Mary."

iii) Inhale deeply "Je-". Exhale slowly "-sus". Keep breathing the name of Jesus, using a rosary if you like: each bead a "Jesus". Maintain an awareness of his Presence in the Silence by paying attention to your breath and prayer word. Get distracted—peacefully return your attention to breathing the Name.

iv) Slowly pray out loud two or more times the Gospel from Mass, or psalm or reading or something from Liturgy of the Hours.

v) Chew on the word, phrase, or image that stuck out to you.

vi) Now breathe the scripture word or phrase with your beads all the while maintaining silence, stillness.

vii) When the timer goes off, end with saying "thank you". Beg for what you and others need.

viii) Depart begging the Spirit, thru Mary, to help you maintain the awareness of Christ's Presence. Continue to chew on your Scripture word throughout the day.

3. Thanks for hanging out these past Tuesdays. Thanks for everyone who jumped up and helped my clumsiness without even being asked. You guys are awesome. I can't wait to be with you again soon. Mardi Gras is coming up—we'll party bigtime then. It'll be great when the weather is nice enough for us to post-up outside the garage. We can invite the neighbors on the block. Until then, will you please listen to the Spirit with me? What is most helpful, most essential for us to live life together in the Christ?
