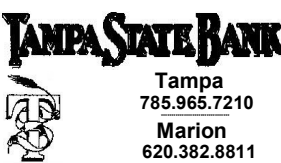

**FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS** for Jimmy Rudolph to be held at Pilsen: Vigil on Thurs., Feb. 2nd, 6pm. Rosary on Fri., Feb. 3rd, 10am, followed by funeral Mass. Please keep his soul and his family in your prayers. **NOTE:** *There will be no daily Mass in Marion on Friday, but there will be a Tampa Mass at 7pm.*

**BLESSING OF THROATS:** The feast day of St. Blaise is Fri., Feb. 3rd. At the TM 7pm Mass on that day, Fr. Isaac will give the Blessing of Throats.

**USHER TRAINING:** Beginning with the Feb. 5th week-end Masses, Fr. Isaac will have the offertory gifts brought up, and the collection taken up by the ushers. There are minor changes from the previous procedure:  
OFFERTORY: When petitions **start**, the ushers and gift bearers go to the back of church to prepare. As soon as people sit down, ushers begin the collection. FL [2 ushers] & PL [4 ushers] use the long-handled baskets as in the past. MN [2 ushers, 4 baskets] go up the side aisles and assist people as the baskets are passed around. All money is dumped into one basket [PL uses a wooden box] and brought up by the gift bearers. Process up as soon as possible; do not wait for Father’s signal, he will come forward to meet the group.  
**MONEY COLLECTION:** After the ushers hand out bulletins, two ushers take the money basket into the sacristy and put the money in the white secure envelope which then goes into the black bank bag and is locked.

**LENTEN STUDY:** A Lenten study, *Return*, will be held at the MAC after the MN 7pm Stations of the Cross, beginning Fri., Feb. 24th. Reorient your mind and heart this Lent so you can more fully experience the joy of Easter—Christ’s victory over sin and death. In this beautiful guided journal for prayer and meditation, Fr. John Burns—author of the bestselling and award-winning book *Adore*—invites you to strip away your confusion, attachments, and sin so you can return to the Lord and undergo real and lasting conversion. In the liturgy’s first reading on Ash Wednesday, the prophet Joel call us to wholehearted conversion: “Even now, says the Lord, return to me, with your whole heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning, rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the Lord, your God” (Jl 2:12–13). Each week throughout Lent, Burns breaks down these two verses. Then, during Holy Week and the Resurrection on Easter, you are invited to weave your own stories into that of the Paschal Mystery. Burns uses the opening prayer of each day’s Mass, called the Collect, as a starting point for your meditations through the forty days leading up to Easter Sunday. He also focuses on the traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, which come together as our sacred penance during this solemn season, and ultimately lead us to heaven. Each day of *Return* includes the prayer from the Collect, an inspiring meditation, thought-provoking reflection questions, and a prayer. *Continued from front >>* **A NOTE FROM FR. ISAAC** *continued*  
I just found out this past Friday that I might have the opportunity to interview POW Mike Dowe soon. We’ll see. Emil seems to make things happen if he wants to.  
Here is the link for the big cultural event in New York City: [newyorkencounter.org](https://newyorkencounter.org). There you can find the entire program. The presentation should be available live online—stay tuned. Or you can come in person. :-) I’ll be there. Here is the event’s theme—I think you’ll see why the event’s organizers accepted our proposal to do the climactic presentation on Fr. Kapaun:  
***Who am I that you care for me?***  
*It’s clear now. Two years of pandemic have shown us that the image of the self-sufficient, autonomous individual cannot stand up to the growing lack of motivation and the epidemic of loneliness, mental illness, gun violence. Likewise, the new paradigm of diversity, equity, and inclusion seems inadequate to respond to the concrete problems of division, injustice, and estrangement. Intriguing phenomena have appeared: the “great resignation,” the rise of influencers, the spread of cryptocurrencies, the metaverse. And then the specter of inflation and recession. Lastly, the war in Ukraine has taken us by surprise. Its images of unspeakable violence have reminded us of the mysterious existence of evil, and of our radical inability to deal with it, either as victims or perpetrators.*  
*In the face of all of this, a desire for more genuine connections and real community has emerged, the perception that we are somehow interdependent. At a deeper level, the more I feel uncertain, ill-equipped to face life, deceived by empty promises, the stronger I ache to be seen, accepted, affirmed by someone in flesh and blood.*  
*I yearn for someone who is not uncomfortable with my brokenness, put off by my failures, or embarrassed by my sadness. Someone who values my deeper questions, who is certain of the meaning of life and walks with me to meet it. Someone who knows me and, inexplicably, really cares for me.*  
***Why do I have this yearning?***  
*But when you said: you,*  
*to me, yes, to me singled out,*  
*I was higher than stars,*  
*deeper than coral. ...*  
*You gave me possession of myself*  
*when you gave your self to me.*  
*—Pedro Salinas, “When you chose me”*
