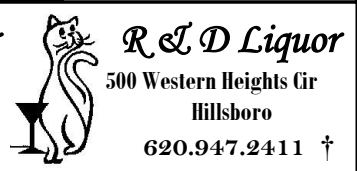
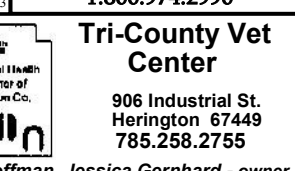

HUNGRY FOR CHRIST: Holy Family Parish has Fasting Group for encouragement & support. The goal of the group is to fast on Fridays throughout the year for the salvation of souls and any other intentions. **Here’s how it works:** You will receive an email prior to the fast day. You choose the level at which you would like to participate. After the fast day, you will receive an email that will call for a self-determined “grade” on a scale of 0-10. This is purely voluntary, but it allows the facilitator to report an aggregate of our efforts. You should give yourself extra credit for attending Mass, a holy hour & other devotions. Add one credit for each item added to the fast. You should subtract from your score if you are lacking in charity, such as being cross with your family or others. Church Regulations Regarding Fast and Abstinence

Abstinence from meat (beast or fowl) is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years & older on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits eating meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments, even though made from animal fat.

LATIN CHANT MASS: During the season of Lent, the Chant Mass in Latin will be used, beginning with blue hymnal #177.
