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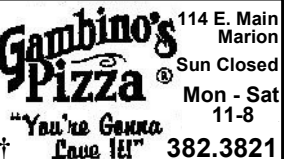
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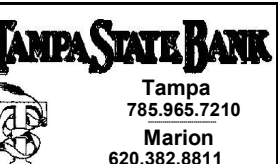

**Feast days for week of April 23rd: Mon., St. Fidelis of Sigma-
ringen, Priest, Martyr:** Fidelis, died 1622 in Switzerland; known as
the “lawyer of the poor” before becoming a Capuchin; protomartyr of
Propaganda Fide. **Tues., St. Mark, Evangelist:** Mark, died 1st
century; cousin of Barnabas; associated with Sts. Paul & Peter; the
Gospel ascribed to him is the oldest (written probably prior to the fall
of Jerusalem in 70 AD) & shortest; tradition holds Mark as the 1st
bishop of Alexandria; portrayed as a winged lion; patron of notaries,
of Egypt, & of Venice. **Wed., Easter Weekday Thurs., East-
er Weekday Fri., St. Peter Chanel, Priest, Martyr; St.**

Louis Grignion de Montfort, Priest: Peter Mary Chanel, died 1841; French Marist
missionary on the Pacific islands of Wallis & Futuna where he was martyred; de-
stroyed cult of evil spirits; protomartyr & patron of Oceania. Louis Mary de Montfort,
died 1716; hospital chaplain & founder of the Congregation of the Daughters of Wis-
dom; founded the Missionaries of the Company of Mary, today numbering about 860
religious; chief work: *True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin*. **Sat., St. Catherine of
Siena, Virgin, Doctor of the Church:** Catherine, died 1380; O.P. tertiary, mystic, &
author (*The Dialogue*); peacemaker within the Church & renewer of religious life;
worked toward ending the Avignon papacy under Gregory XI; declared doctor of the
Church in 1970; patroness of Italy and, together with St. Bridget of Sweden & St. Te-
resa Benedicta of the Cross, co-patroness of Europe. **4th Sunday of Easter:**
Acts 2:14a, 36-41 1 Pt 2:20b-25 Jn 10:1-10

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION:

First Reconciliation will be Saturday, May 6th at the Marion church. The children will participate in a First Reconciliation retreat from 9am-2pm beginning in MAC with a light breakfast before going to the church, and conclude with receiving the sacrament of Reconciliation and renewal of baptismal promises.
