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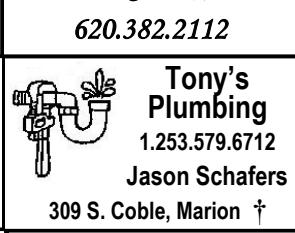
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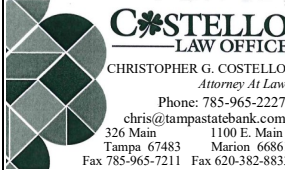
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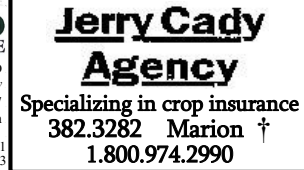

Feast days for week of April 30th: Mon., St. Joseph the Worker Tues., St. Athanasius, Bishop, Doctor of the Church: Athanasius, died 373; bishop of Alexandria 45 years; champion of Nicea; prolific polemicist against the Arians who exiled him 5 times; one of the four great doctors of the Eastern Church; known as the “Doctor of the Incarnation.”
Wed., Saints Philip & James, Apostles: Philip, died 1st cen.; from Bethsaida; among the 1st disciples called by Jesus; tradition holds he preached in Phrygia, dying on a cross at Hierapolis; with James, venerated as the patron saints of Uruguay. James, died 62; son of Alphaeus; surnamed “the Less” or “the Just” for his piety; leader of the Jerusalem Church; an epistle is ascribed to him; believed to have been beaten or stoned to death; patron of the dying; both saints mentioned in the Roman Canon.

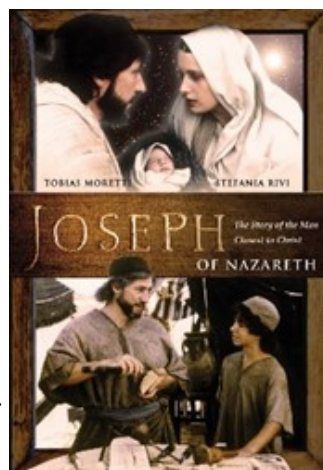
