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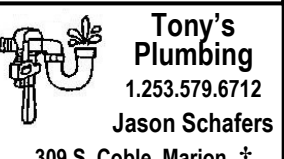

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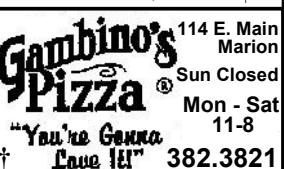

Feast days for week of May 28th: Mon., The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church: In 2018, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued a Decree implementing Pope Francis' decision that this Memorial be inscribed in the General Roman Calendar & observed on the Monday following Pentecost, taking precedence over conflicting Obligatory Memorials. The joyous veneration given to the Mother of God by the contemporary Church, in light of reflection on the mystery of Christ and on His nature, cannot ignore the figure of a woman, the Virgin Mary, who is both the Mother of Christ and Mother of the Church. **Tues., Weekday**
Wed., The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary
Thurs., St. Justin, Martyr: Justin, died 165 under Marcus Aurelius; authored *Apology* and *Dialogue with Trypho*; layman & apologist who gives one of the earliest descriptions of the Mass; patron of philosophers & apologists. **Fri., Sts. Marcellinus & Peter, martyrs:** Marcellinus, presbyter, & Peter, exorcist, died 303; beheaded under Diocletian; both mentioned in the Roman Canon. **Sat., Charles Lwanga & Companions, martyrs:** Charles Lwanga & 21 Ugandan companions, died Nov. 15, 1885 - Jan. 27, 1887; proto-martyrs of Black Africa; over 100 killed in this period, including Anglicans; Charles is the patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action.

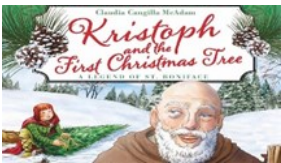
