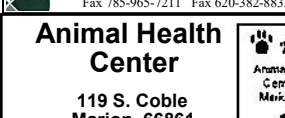
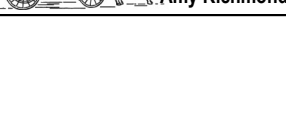

Feast days for week of June 18th: Mon., St. Romuald, abbot: Romuald, died 1027; from Ravenna; founded the Camaldolese hermits, today numbering about 95 members; urged contemplative prayer through solitude, silence & fast-ing. Tues., Weekday Wed., St. Aloysius Gonzaga, religious: Aloysius Gonzaga, Jesuit scholastic, died 1591 at age 23 caring for the sick; from the princely family of Castiglio-ne; renounced inheritance to enter the Jesuits; St. Robert Bel-larmine was his spiritual director; strongly devoted to the Eu-charist, interior prayer, & charitable service; patron of youth & of students in Jesuit colleges & universities. Thurs., St. Paulinus of Nola, Bishop; Sts. John Fisher, Bishop, & Thomas More, Martyrs: Paulinus, died 431; husband & fa-ther who gave his possessions to the poor; dedicated bishop, especially during the Visigoth invasions. John Fisher, be-headed 1535; bishop of Rochester; renowned for his preaching & educational reforms; defender of Church tradition against Luther, & of the Roman primacy against Henry VIII. Thomas More, beheaded 1535; humanist & chancellor of England; wrote *Utopia*; refused to support Henry VIII's divorce of Queen Catherine & his Act of Supremacy; patron of lawyers, statesmen, & politicians. 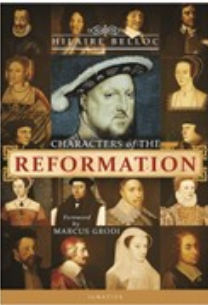

FROM FR. ISAAC:

WARNING: do not read the rules below outside the context of a real relationship with Jesus and His New Body, the Church, with all His members here at Holy Family.

To the first Christians gathered in Corinth, Paul wrote a letter saying:

The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf . . . Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily will have to answer for the body and blood of the Lord. A person should examine himself, and so eat the bread and drink the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body, eats and drinks judgment on himself (*1Corinthians10:16-17; 11:27-29*).

What are the requirements of receiving Communion worthily? Meaning, how can I live in communion fully with Jesus and my brothers and sisters, and therefore satisfy the deepest desires of Christ’s heart and your heart and my heart?

One must:

- be baptized and confirmed Catholic (a baptized child can receive after her First Communion and before her Confirmation)
- believe Holy Communion is the person of the resurrected Jesus, his Flesh and Blood and Heart.
- confess out loud to a priest in Confession each mortal sin before receiving Communion worthily.
- fast one hour before receiving from all food and drink, including gum (excluding water and medications).

One can receive Communion worthily:

- kneeling or standing, after a bow at the waste while one is the next person in line.
- on the tongue by sufficiently opening your mouth and sticking out your tongue.
- on the hand by placing your dominant hand under your non-dominant hand. Keep your non-dominant hand flat. Receive the host IMMEDIATELY before walking away, and as you walk away check for any crumbs on your hand and fingers that NEED to be consumed as well. Each crumb of the host is the fullness of the person of Jesus. If one of your hands is occupied, receive on the tongue.

- After you have consumed the Communion, praise the Father out loud in song with the entire Body of Christ you have just become one with. Then take a sufficient moment of silence resting in the slow burning stillness of His Presence and this new pulsing oneness.
