Summer 2024: Prayer and Action:

A note from Fr. Isaac

I want each of our high schoolers (graduating 8th graders through graduating seniors) to join me for a week of Prayer and Action this summer in Kingman. We'll all be going together June 16-21. I have participated in many high school retreats as an adult leader, as a priest, and as a high schooler (Steubenville, TEC, Camp Totus Tuus, etc.), and I have seen the Spirit work in all of them. The one that I have found to be most helpful and most enjoyable is Prayer and Action. More than any of the other good retreats, Prayer and Action has taught me how to recognize Christ as actually present on a normal day in the concrete Sacred Community and the Sacred Poor, in the Sacred Mysteries and the Sacred Silence. I want all of us to direct our common energy to do this one retreat together. It's important we do a retreat experience together. We will need adult chaperones (I have witnessed over and over again the adults experiencing Christ present on a week of Prayer and Action just as much as the high schoolers). With all of our energy directed to this one retreat, the Parish will pay for the entirety of the retreat for both high schoolers and chaperones. BISHOP KEMME CHANGES TIME OF CONFIRMATION MASS

New Venue and Time

Confirmation in our parish is scheduled for Sat., March 2nd, but recently the time was changed by the Bishop due to an unexpected scheduling conflict. The time was changed to 5pm on Saturday, March 2nd.

NOTE: changed Mass venue on Saturday night to facilitate Confirmation, this Saturday only:

- * Saturday, March 2nd, 5pm Mass **at Pilsen** followed by a meal for everyone
- * Sunday, March 3rd, 8:30am Mass at Marion
- * Sunday, March 3rd, 10:30am Mass at Pilsen followed by Charity Auction

Children 6th grade and older will be confirmed.

**Church Regulations Regarding
Fast and Abstinence**

Abstinence from meat (beast or fowl) is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years & older on Ash Wednesday & on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits eating meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments, even though made from animal fat. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a fast day. Catholics who are 18 years old but not yet 59 years are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Also, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Stations will be held at MN & PL on Fridays during Lent at **6pm**, please note the time change. Fr. Isaac will rotate between the sites, leading the Stations and hearing Confessions afterwards till all are heard. On Fri., Feb. 16th, Fr. Isaac will be away on retreat so Stations will be held, but there will be no Confessions. On Feb. 23, and March 15, Fr. Isaac will hear Confessions after Stations in MN. On Fri., March 1st, Fr. Isaac will celebrate First Friday Mass at Tampa, with Confessions and Stations before. On March 8 and 22, Fr. Issac will hear Confessions after Stations in PL.
