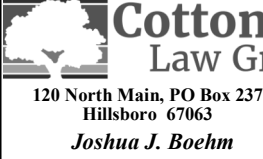
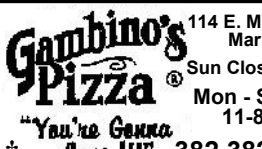
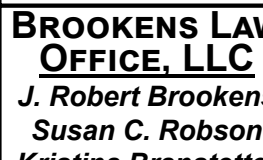

Feast Days for the week of Nov. 11th

Mon., St. Josaphat, bishop, martyr: Josaphat Kuncevych, died 1623; born in Poland, raised Ukrainian Orthodox, becoming a Basilian monk of the Ruthenian Rite; bishop of Polotsk; his fidelity to the Roman See & his desire for union between the Ukrainian Church & Rome led to his murder at Vitebsk; 1st formally canonized saint of the Eastern Rite. Tues., St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, Virgin: Frances Xavier Cabrini, died in Chicago 1917; youngest of 13 children; founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart; for 28 years labored in U.S. & South America, establishing some 67 institutions (schools, hospitals & orphanages); 1st U.S. citizen canonized; patroness of immigrants & migrants. Wed., Weekday Thur., St. Albert the Great, bishop, doctor of the Church: Albert, died 1280; O.P. master of philosophy, theology, & the natural sciences, especially Aristotle; teacher of St. Thomas Aquinas; bishop of Regensburg; prolific writer (38 quarto volumes in print); patron of scientists. Fri., St. Margaret of Scotland; St. Gertrude, Virgin: Margaret, died 1093; from Hungary; wife of King Malcolm III of Scotland & mother of 8; helped root out paganism; her love for the poor became legendary; patroness of Scotland. Gertrude, called "the Great," died 1301; mystic of the famous Benedictine abbey of Helfta in Saxony; wrote on the meaning of suffering, the Sacred Heart, the Trinity, & God's love. Sat., St. Elizabeth of Hungary, religious: Elizabeth, died 1231 at age 24; wife of Louis IV of Thuringia & mother of 3; as a widow, she became a Franciscan tertiary, dedicated to the needs of the poor & the sick; canonized only 4 years after her death; patroness of the Franciscan Third Order & of Catholic charities. 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time: Dn 12:1-3 Heb 10:11-14, 18 Mk 13:24-32
