Church Regulations Regarding Fast and Abstinence

Abstinence from meat (beast or fowl) is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years & older on Ash Wednesday & on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits eating meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments, even though made from animal fat.

Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a fast day. Catholics who are 18 years old but not yet 59 years are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Also, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted.
